And the tools do often change. So, for example, in some of the other types of training I've done with this, like Easy AI Trending Wall Art, which I highly recommend you also refer to if you want to get even more in depth with, , setting this type of thing up, I recommended playground.ai.

Well, playground.ai is no longer available to do the type of wall art that we're talking about, so we do have a lot of other options, though, and new options that are coming through. We have Canva Dreamlabs, so I haven't heard a lot of people talk about this. I think it's relatively new, but basically, It's part of Canva Pro, so if you have Canva Pro, then you can go ahead and use that.you get 500 uses a month.

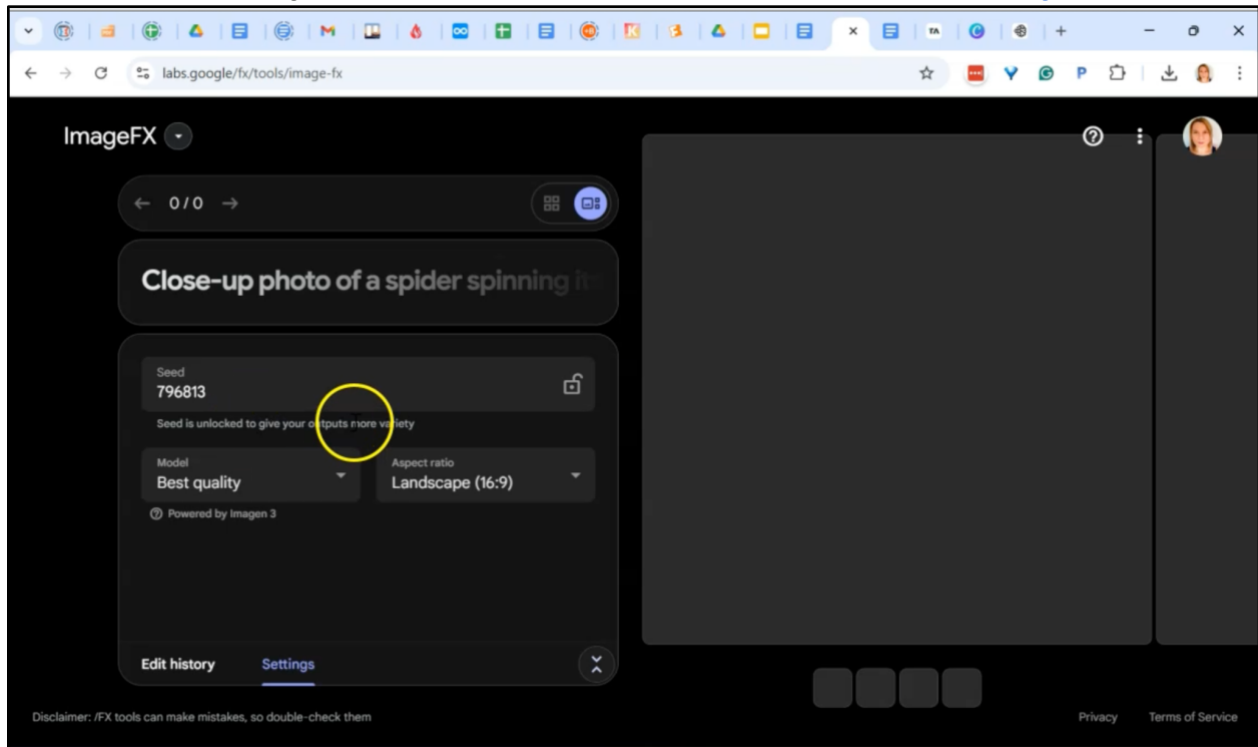
And another tool is called tensor.art. You get 50 credits a day for free, and they do have paid versions available. Google has a new tool out called, it's in their labs right now, so it's free. You can, I don't, they'll probably roll out some type of pricing at some point, but it's free with your Google account.

You can also use the image creator in ChatGPT, and [Ideogram AI](https://ideogram.ai) often has free available until they get full, and then [Midjourney](https://midjourney.com), of course, is completely paid, but it is very good. So, depending on what you have, you may already have Canva Pro, you can start with that. If you have the ChatGPT, I'm not sure if it's under the paid or free version, but you can use their image creator.

[TensorArt](#), you could try out Google Labs if you have a Gmail or a Google account, most people have something like that you can try out. So there's a lot of different tools available, and I did design the prompts so you can use them for a wide variety of different tools. So let's go ahead here and take a look at some of these tools.

Let's go ahead and use one of our prompts so we can sort of see how things might be different. This is the one we were looking at a little bit earlier in the other video, nature inspired, serene forest scene. So let's go ahead and take a look at this one. So this is called [ImageFX](#).



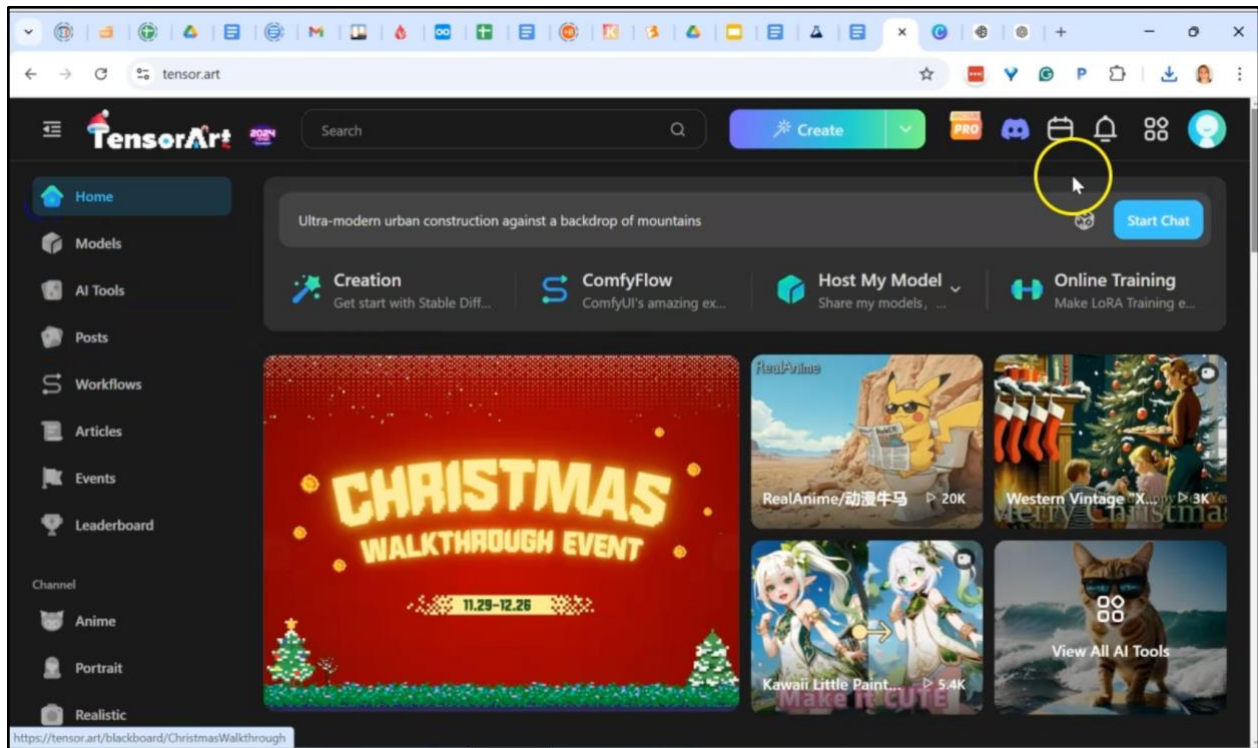
This is [Google Labs](#). So you can just do, and it'll give you like the four variations here. It'll give you more variety, the model. So you can see here, and then the landscape. Let's do landscape because it is a landscape, basically. But, it's very basic here. They don't really give you a lot of choice, so you can just sort of see how it goes.

So let's go here and create. Okay, so we have it here. It just took a moment or so, but there are four variations. They're very similar looking, so I think you would just pick the one that you like the most. And then you have the option to download. It does download into a JPEG here. And, it doesn't really allow me to give it a title yet.

I guess you would just title it when you download it. And you can redo it. You can copy the prompt. So you do have some things, but you can see it's very basic. It's pretty plug and play, but you still get pretty good results out of it, I think. And my understanding is this is for commercial use. There's not a limitation on it.

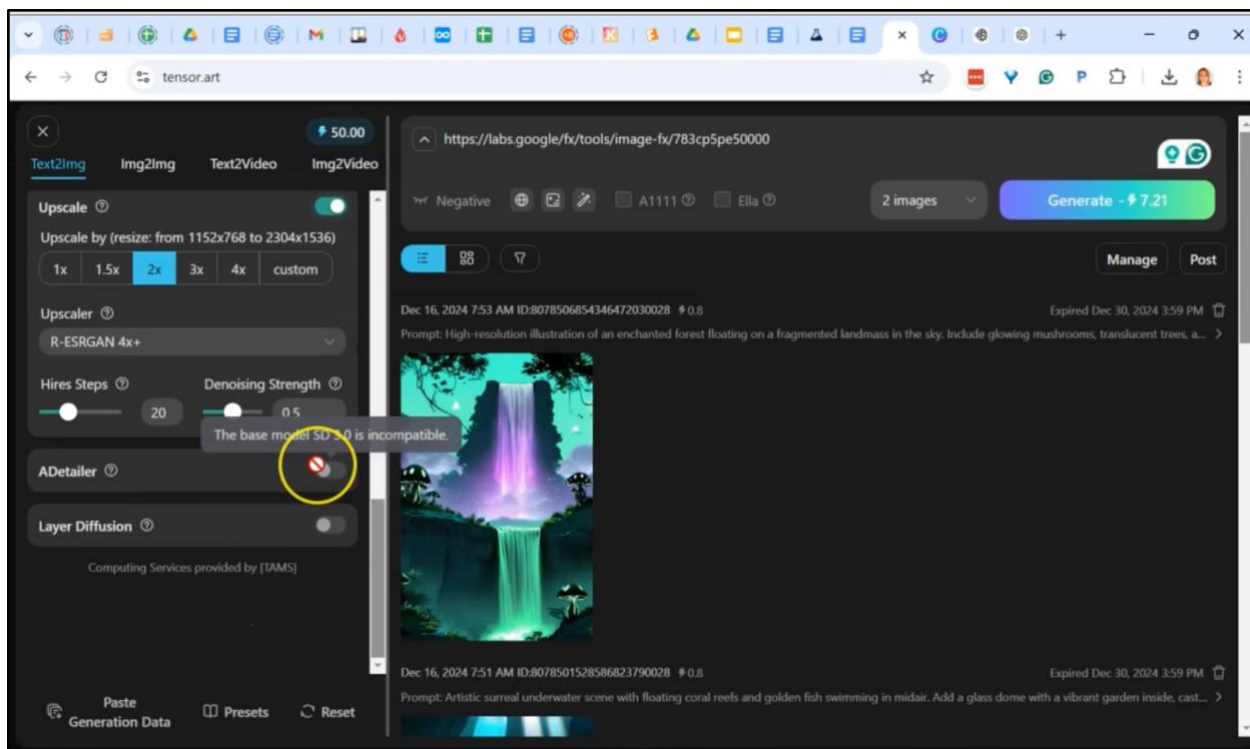
I did look at terms of service. And because it's in their labs right now, they're just still working it out. So this is the Labs Google, their new ImageFX. And let's go ahead here and go over to TensorArt. Now TensorArt is much more, they have a lot more models and things like that. So you have a lot of different models here you can use.



You do get 50 credits a day and you can do more, of course. So if you come here. You see here that they have a lot of different models. This is the basic one here. You get the 50, you can do text to image, image to image, text to video. So for this one I believe I was doing this as some previous ones I was doing a surreal design.

And you can of course pick some different ones here. Real time generate. So they have a lot of tools. This is a lot more complicated so if we wanted to use this one we have here, we would come here, put in our new one, and then it will tell you, you can expand and improve. These are tools that are, that are I think paid, if you want to do maybe two images.

So, and then this prompts I don't know if I want to use this one. Let's see, settings, let's do the landscape. And then you can do some upscaling as well, which I recommend, even though it'll be a bit more expensive. And then they have some other tools here you can use. And they have a lot of different models here as well.

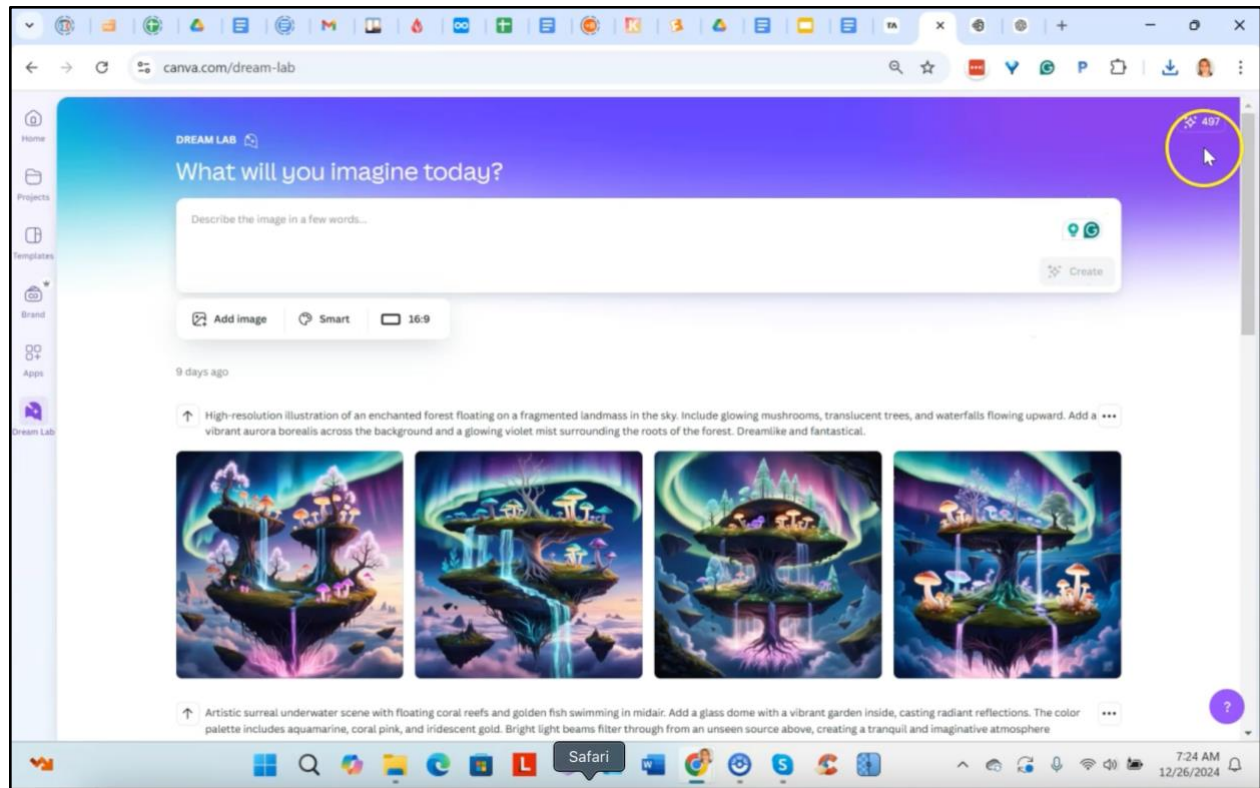
So the one I was using would be good with the surreal ones that we were looking at. , so you can see they have a lot of different ones here. This one looks kind of nice. Let's use this one. Okay, so that's going to take, because I'm doing an upscale as well, which you might want to wait, of course, until after you're actually already done to see if you like it, it's going to take 14 units. Oh it's not doing, oh, and that exceeds the limit, and I put the wrong thing in. So let's go back here and redo this one again. I don't have the right thing in there. Here we go. So like I said, this is very powerful. It might be something that you might want to do, and use and pay for just because it does have a lot of tools.

Oh, it's not even letting me upscale. So like I said, I'm still sort of getting used to this one. Let's go ahead and turn that off and then hopefully it'll let us do that. We can always upscale it later. Here we go. Now it's working. Okay, so we have these here. They took about 30 seconds, and you can see here we have different things.

We can do the upscale. It might let us do that with this. Let me click. I don't know why I meant to do that, but you can see it here. And then you can see, it looks pretty good, I think. I think, again, you're getting, because of the way the prompts are working, you're getting sort of similar output to what we have because of these sort of specific types of prompts.

So if you download it, you can do that. There we go. This is a PNG, which is a bit better image quality than the JPEG that Google is giving us. And then it might let us upscale, download, publish, upscale. So again, it's quite expensive to upscale, so you may not want to do that here. But it does give you the options. So this is tensor.art.



And then I want to take a look here at DreamLab. You can see again I was working here. So this is when you log on to Canva if you have Pro. And it might even be up here if you don't have Pro. You get here. But you have a lot of credits you can use every month. And then, again, it's pretty basic in terms of what the features are.

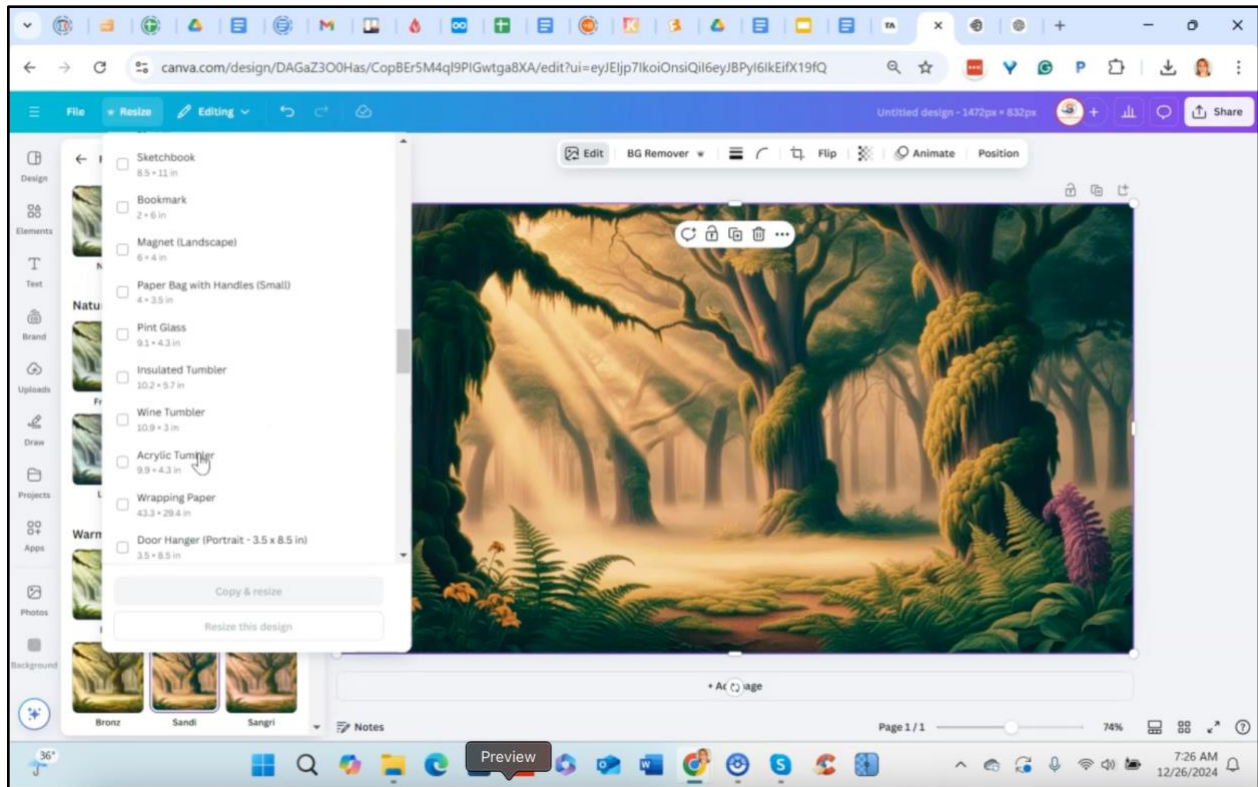
But you can go here. And smart will be, you can select a style, which again is sort of similar to a filter. , maybe cinematic concept or illustration, we're going to keep with the landscape. And let's see here what it'll give us. So I don't think this is bad, but the detail there isn't really as good as I would like it to be.

So you can download it, you can edit. Up here you can edit into a design Image guidance. So it's going to be bringing in some other stuff here soon. So I think Canva is really all going in on this. You can edit it into a design. Which is nice so that is one thing I like about this Is if you're already using Canva for different things.

And I do recommend using Canva for doing some things like setting your size here for example. Like if you're doing your different sizes, then this is helpful because it's easy to use. And then

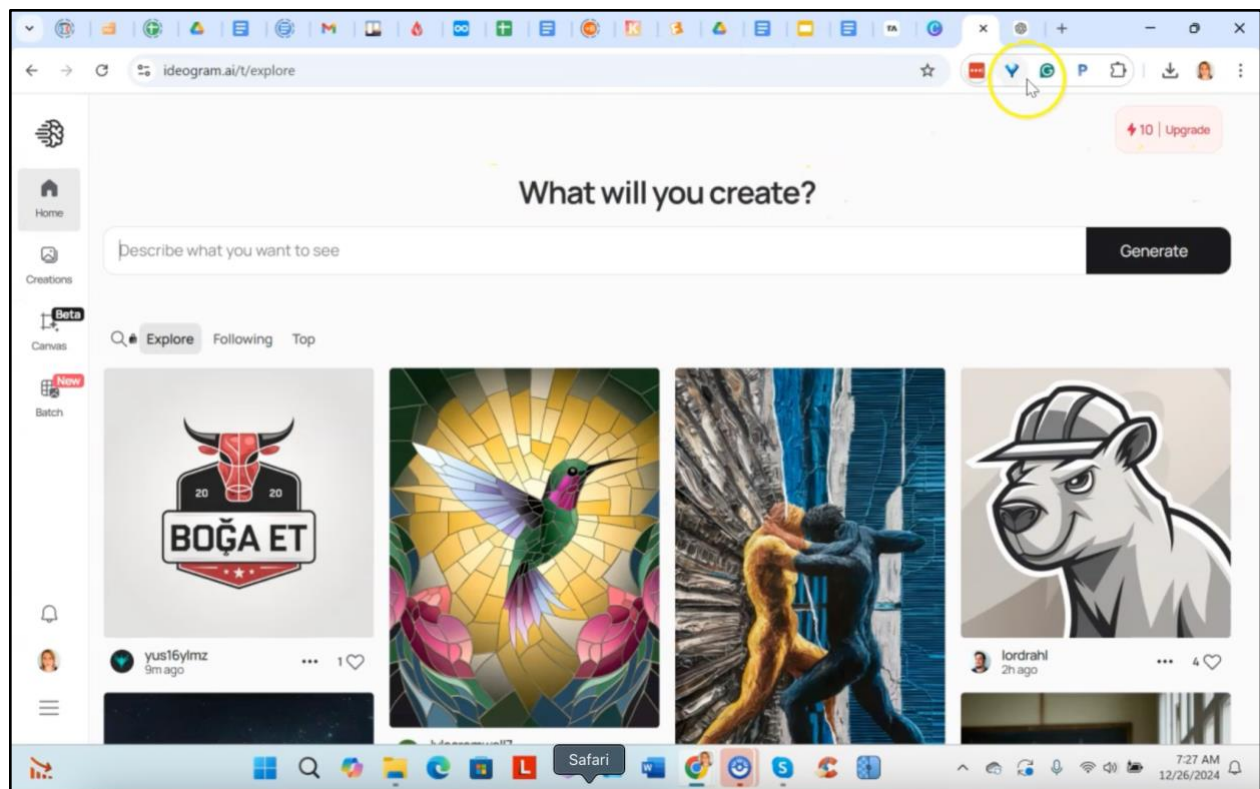

you could even add in some additional filters here if you wanted to, for example. And then you could do the, if you again have the Pro, you can set your sizes.



So if you want to do something with print, you can set it up here. , and you can do your different sizes here, for example. Or have your art, so you could say something like art, framed art, wall art, or something like that, and it'll give you some sizes. And they're not super big here, but anyways, So this gives you options to work seamlessly with Canva if you're using it, but personally, I don't really think the quality is quite as good as what you might get from some of these other ones, but you know, it kind of depends what you're looking for.

Now we have ideogram, and again, this is, can be free, but it often will fill up very quickly with, , in the queue if you don't have the paid version, and it can be slow. So we'll again go here, we'll use the color palette, the later model, and then we'll generate this. So see I have ten, ten credits, and again it gives you a certain amount of credits, I believe for a day or something, so, let's take a look here.

If you did pick up my WordArt product, you'll know that I'm a fan of this particular tool because it's really great. So now we have to wait two minutes, so we'll come back over to this. In fact, instead of pausing, let's just go over to ChatGPT. So I have 4. 0, and then they do have the option now if you click View Tools, you can do pictures, so let's go ahead here while we're waiting on that and see what we can get with this.

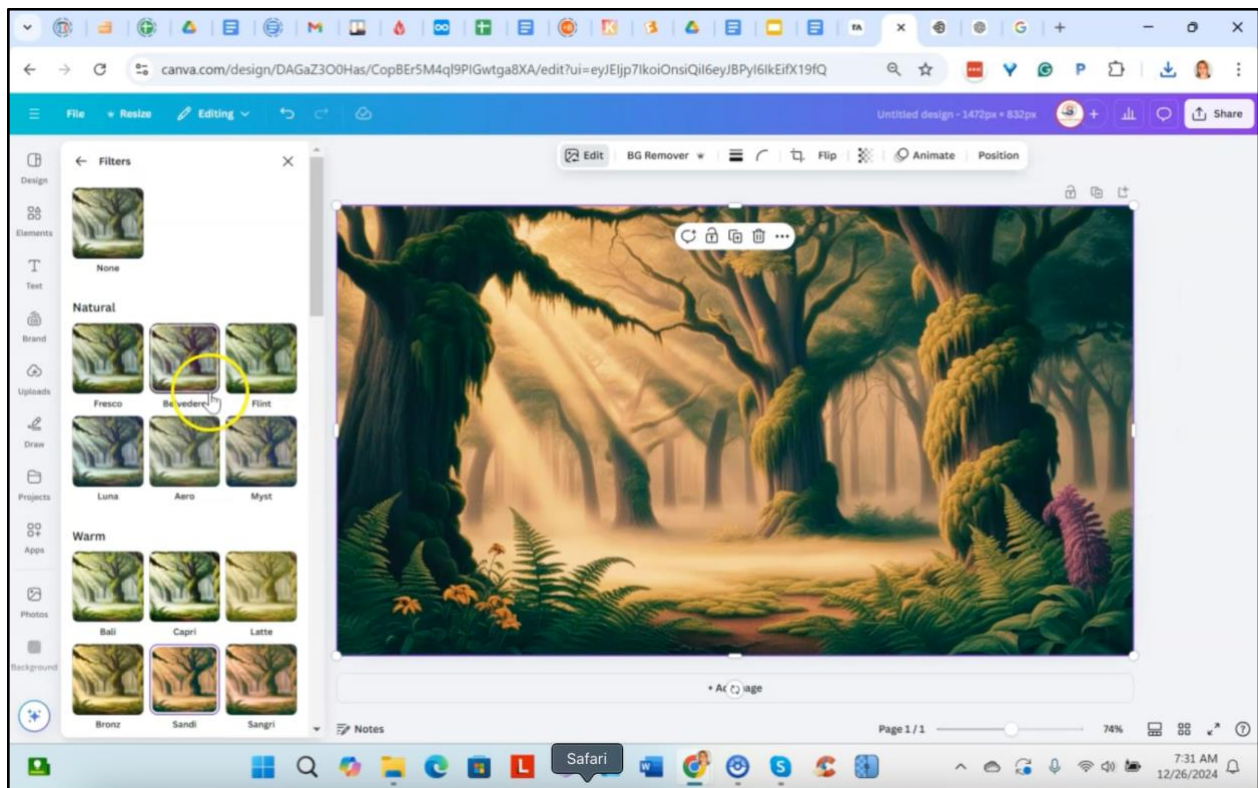
Okay, I think that's pretty good. It doesn't actually, again, give us a ton of different things to do. Let's take a look at it. Yeah, it doesn't really give us a lot. But then if you want to download it, , it does this sort of weird web thing. I forgot what it's called, but you can then take it and then change it.

Or you can click on here and just save the image as, which is pretty cool. And see it's this sort of a web file. And then, , you can, can, can use it. And import it. I believe Canva lets you import web files or you can use some type of converter. Let's come back over here. We're still waiting. So you can see there's some tools here that'll convert the WebP to JPEG or, or Canva also does that for you just because that's a thing.

Or you can do PNG and so forth. Still waiting on Enneagram. Okay, so here we are. I do think the quality of this is quite good. I think it's one of the better qualities. And so you can, if you have the Pro, you can upscale or do some other stuff with it, and if not, you can just go ahead here and you can just download it.

So again, they have some features, but they really want you to use the paid version. But I do think that this is quite good. I think they're one of the best generators out there, aside from Midjourney. So, I'm not going to be prompting Midjourney with this, just because they don't have a free version.



But if you have Midjourney, it's pretty similar. You would just put that in there and use it. And the quality is probably the best out of the tools I've shared. But you can see that you can get by with all of these. I don't like I said, I think that it depends on the type of prompt that you're using with the Canva DreamLab.

I didn't think this was as detailed as some of the other ones. But again, it might depend on the prompt. So this is a good overview of some of these samplers of these image creators. And you might even have something else. So, for example, I've also shared tools that you can get for a one time fee where you can actually use them and they have a variety of art tools you can use.

So basically, with this particular income stream, you don't necessarily need to buy into one specific type of tool like MidJourney. It's great, but you can use a lot of free tools to get started and there's more and more tools now coming out on the market.
